Are you a retiree, beneficiary or a former member who received payments from TRS in 2023, such as annuity payments, death benefits or a refund? If so, TRS will begin mailing 1099-R forms for tax year 2023 in mid-January 2024.

Explanations of all boxes on your 1099-R form are found on the back side of the form. Since TRS receives many questions about some of those boxes, we have explained several below.

To change your tax withholding preference online, you must be registered for <u>MyTRS</u>. Click the *MyTRS* login button on the TRS website's homepage (<u>www.trs.texas.gov</u>), log in, and select Modify Withholding Preference. Otherwise, to change your withholding preference, please complete Form W-4P – <u>Withholding Certificate for Periodic Pension or Annuity Payments</u> and submit it to TRS. You may also call 1-800-223-8778 to request the form through our automated telephone system.

TRS will mail the 1099-R form to your address on file with TRS. If you have not received your copy by mid-February, there are several other ways to obtain a copy.

- View and print your 1099-R online from <u>MyTRS</u> on the TRS website (<u>www.trs.texas.gov</u>). You must be registered for MyTRS to be able to access your form. Once you're signed in, you can access your 1099-R in the Document Center.
- Retirees and beneficiaries, as well as members who have withdrawn/refunded their contributions, can log in to *MyTRS* to view and print their 1099-R.
- Call TRS toll-free at 1-800-223-8778 and use the automated telephone system. Have your participant ID available. Follow the menu prompts to request a 1099-R form, which TRS will mail. We will only send the copy to the home address on file for you.
- Send a letter to TRS (1000 Red River St, Austin, TX 78701-2698). If you have moved, TRS must have your address change request *in writing*. Therefore, the best course of action is to request a duplicate 1099-R along with your written address change. Please include your participant ID and signature on the request.
